Some areas of the UK are more susceptible to subsidence and this, therefore, is reflected in an insurer's requirements and premiums.
- A detailed health report on a tree that is adjacent to a pedestrian area, roadway or any other area that may expose members of the public and public property to damage. With the aim of mitigating any liability of the owner of the tree, this report can be presented in the case of damage being caused by a fallen branch.
